Choose at least 1 activity a night

<p>Slap-A-Word</p> <p>Spread out the word cards. Listen to an adult call out a word. Slap the word you hear.</p>	<p>Rainbow Writing</p> <p>Write each of your words with a different color. Read the words 3 times each.</p>	<p>Word Hunt</p> <p>Ask someone from your family to place the words around your home. Find and read the words.</p>
<p>Silly Voices</p> <p>Read your words 5 times each. Use a different silly voice each time.</p>	<p>Hop To It</p> <p>Spread out the word cards on the floor. Listen to an adult call out a word. Hop to the word you hear.</p>	<p>Read & Sort</p> <p>Read your words. Sort the words by the number of letters.</p>
<p>Spotlight Words</p> <p>Spread out the word cards on the floor. Turn off the lights. Use a flashlight to light up the words. Read the lit up words.</p>	<p>Flash!</p> <p>Use your word cards as flash cards. Time yourself and see how fast you can read your words!</p>	<p>Read & Write</p> <p>Read a word and turn the card over. Try to spell the word without looking at the card.</p>

Sight word mastery is crucial for your child's success as a reader. Many sight words cannot be sounded out (decoded). Therefore, they must be memorized. Sight words also represent some of the most common words in written language.
